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**Amarinth gains Petronas approved vendor status and
signs Geveke Oil & Gas Malaysia as new agent**

Bhd. as its regional agent.

The significant Malaysian market for the oil and gas industry is now more available to Amarith for its range of high quality API 610 centrifugal pumps which the company is able to deliver on unrivalled short lead times for onshore and offshore applications. Amarith has recently been awarded approved vendor status by Petronas, the certification necessary to provide equipment into the majority of the oil and gas projects in the region.

The Petronas approval now enables Amarinth to do business with the EPC contractors and their supply chain within Malaysia.

With the conclusion of the Petronas approved vendor status, Amarinth will also be supporting Geveke Oil & Gas Malaysia at Oil & Gas Asia 2011 on the 1st – 3rd June on Stand 5409.
